Throughout his paper Jack Dominian emphasises married love as an expression of faithfulness and forgiveness and he reminds us that it reflects the image of God who, because of his love, sent his Son to renew his Covenant when we had failed. He asks the Teams of Our Lady to reflect the image of God as the Spiritual dimension in the way we live out our commitment to each other. Dr Dominian challenges us to evangelisation. He asks us to use everyday, ordinary events to do extraordinary things and to be witnesses where the earthly and the Divine meet in the domestic church.

Possible questions for Study No 5

1. Does Dr Dominian offer you any new insights into your understanding of what a loving relationship needs to sustain it?
2. The wholeness of a loving relationship is Dr Dominian's theme. What dimension, insight or image offered in the study of the paper helped you to understand the nature of love?
3. As a beacon light that can be focused on the fact that marriage is central to the life of the church, we have been challenged to evangelisation. What is your reaction to this? What can be done to answer the challenge?

Aims. To understand and appreciate marriage as a central point to the life of the church. To discover our willingness and ability to being a "guiding light". To search for our readiness to answer affirmatively to this challenge of evangelisation.

Objectives. To rediscover ourselves as a person and as a couple. To see each other's point of view For the couple to discover their talents, availability, commitment and willingness to take up the challenge.
